The TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment is the cornerstone qualification of the Australian vocational education and training (VET) sector. It is the entry level qualification needed by trainers and assessors to be qualified to deliver and make decisions regarding competence in nationally recognised training.

Online Self-Paced or Workshop Intensives

The TAE upgrade program is for trainers and assessors who hold the previous TAE40110 qualification and wish to upgrade to meet the new compliance standards. The gap study required to upgrade is dependent on the current qualification and units of competency held and the outcome the candidate is seeking. This may include upgrading specific units or upgrading to the full TAE40116. Candidates will provide evidence of previous training, and competency which will be assessed against their required outcome before enrolment. Credit Transfer and RPL assessment (additional fees apply) will be available as part of this pre-enrolment assessment.

Entry Requirements: Candidates must show evidence of currency and provide previous qualifications for authentication and other training for verification.

Course Duration: 3 months
