

Summary of Unit of Competency

The HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults. The unit of competency applies to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies. This unit of competency incorporates HLTAID003 Provide first aid and HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Study Duration

Blended Online

Students have 3 months to complete HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting.

Face-to-Face Tutorials

HLTAID004 Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting 8-hour class with approximately 2 hours of unsupervised online pre-course study.

Industry Opportunities

This unit of competency is suitable for anyone working in day care, family day care, preschool and outside of school hours (OOSH) care services.

Educational Pathways

Following the successful completion of this unit of competency, students may choose to further their learning and complete HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid or HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation.

Course Requirements

Entry Requirements

Assessment
