



# PROVIDE ADVANCED FIRST AID

## Summary of Unit of Competency

The HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide an advanced first aid response, including management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance. The unit of competency applies to workers who may be required to provide, coordinate and manage a first aid response across a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings. This unit of competency incorporates HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation, HLTAID003 Provide first aid, and HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

## Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for the HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid unit of competency, however participants should have the physical ability to meet the considerable physical demands of the practical skills including HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

## Unit of Competency Outcome

Upon successful completion of this unit of competency, students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid, incorporating HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation, HLTAID003 Provide first aid, and HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Please note:

- HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid needs to be renewed every three years in line with industry standards.
- HLTAID007 Provide advanced resus needs to be renewed every 12 months, in line with industry standards.

## Industry Opportunities

### Advanced First Aid Officer

This unit of competency suits the requirement for First Aiders within various industries especially those working in manufacturing, construction, mining or any occupation involving remote or hazardous work.

## Study Duration

### Blended Online

Students have 2 weeks to complete HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid.

### Face to Face Tutorials

HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid 3-day class with approximately 2 hours of unsupervised online pre-course study.
