



Summary of Unit of Competency

The HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid unit of competency describes the skills and knowledge required to provide an advanced first aid response, including management of the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance. The unit of competency applies to workers who may be required to provide, coordinate and manage a first aid response across a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings. This unit of competency incorporates HLTAID007 Provide advanced resuscitation, HLTAID003 Provide first aid, and HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Study Duration

Blended Online

Students have 2 weeks to complete HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid.

Face-to-Face Tutorials

HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid 3-day class with approximately 2 hours of unsupervised online pre-course study.

Industry Opportunities

Advanced First Aid Officer

This unit of competency suits the requirement for First Aiders within various industries especially those working in manufacturing, construction, mining or any occupation involving remote or hazardous work.

Educational Pathways

Following the successful completion of this unit of competency, students may choose to further their learning pathway and complete HLTAID008 Manage first aid services and resources. This unit of competency may also provide credit towards a range of qualifications at Certificate IV and Diploma levels.

Assessment
